**J**acquelin J. Daniel understood the value of time well spent. In addition to a successful personal and professional life, he carried on a rich family tradition of civic service. A review of his lifetime accomplishments reflects a strong commitment to his community, particularly to the young and to education. This commitment manifested itself in the key role he played in expanding and improving the State University System of Florida.

J.J. Daniel served as a member of the state Board of Regents and its predecessor, the Board of Control, and chaired both boards during his 15-year tenure. From the late 1950s through the 1970s, his leadership abilities were evident as the State University System faced a number of challenges, including the development of a centralized policy-making board for Florida's nine public universities.

As an advocate of accessible public university education, J.J. Daniel was instrumental in establishing the University of North Florida. He was a vocal champion of academic freedom. He recognized the importance of strengthening the ties between the educational and the business communities and acted accordingly. His contributions to the State University System and to the University of North Florida were extraordinary.

J.J. Daniel was a man of action who used his time well -- the University of North Florida, the city of Jacksonville and the state of Florida are richer for it.
