When the body is to be shipped to a distant point, requiring the service of a common carrier, in addition to the removal permit, the body must be accompanied with a transit permit as required by the State Board of Health. This permit must be indorsed by the sexton and returned to the Local Registrar of his district within ten days. If there is no sexton or person in charge of burial ground, the undertaker or person acting as such shall sign same as sexton, giving date of interment. Write across face of permit the words, "No person in charge," and return to Local Registrar of the district in which interment is made within 10 days.
