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


4 Year Trends in Print

- 2011 Book Budget slashed 84%







eResource Budget up 70% in the last 4 years





- Promote the tool






Summary


- Our catalog used to search about 800,000 titles. Now it searches 320 million.
- Database use: Up over 76%
- Database cost/use: Down over 38% (Oct-Feb)
- ILL Charges down 43%



Process Impacts



- Increased diversity in search results
- Reduced acquisitions guesswork
- Rapid availability of content
- Eliminated MARC data loads





New Focus

- Get in or get out
- Content not vendors



- Quality metadata (Do we need I&A's?)
