Coffee beans from all over the world are delivered to the Dupuy Silo Facility in burlap bags, super sacks, and containerized bulk. Maxwell House has a quality lab onsite to test the blend before being sent to the factory for roasting.

This tour is a great opportunity to see “upstream” supply chain activities and processes that deliver the “good to the last drop” flavor blend Maxwell House is famous for.
