Dear Mr. Jones:

The Duval County Hospital Authority operates the Duval Medical Center, a community hospital. The Medical Center, a 256 bed general short-term medical and surgical hospital offers outpatient, emergency room and inpatient services to the more than 100,000 indigent sick of Jacksonville. It is financed primarily through ad valorem tax funds and revenues from various State, Federal and other Agency medical programs. Close relationships with the University of Florida College of Medicine at Gainesville, Florida guide the various residencies and internships as well as other educational programs that are offered at the Duval Medical Center. An informational folder is enclosed.

Five years ago a long range expansion program was begun using Ellerbe Consulting Architects from St. Paul, Minnesota as master planners. As part of the long range program, a 500 bed addition is under construction to be opened in 1971. The addition enlarges the outpatient facilities and emergency room areas and provides generally for an increased scope of services.

Our hospital, like other large community charity hospitals, has had chronic problems in getting adequate financing, particularly from the ad valorem tax sources. A Comprehensive Health Planning Council is active in the Jacksonville area. Much data is available about the medical services, patient origins and the roles to be played by the various hospitals and health care institutions. Financing the enlarged Duval Medical Center in its future must be studied, since the present method seems inadequate. The Planning and Development Committee of the Hospital Authority is seeking consultation particularly about future financing, as well as re-evaluation and re-definition of the Community role of the Duval Medical Center.
