CATALOG DISTRIBUTION

A mass bulk rate mailing of the UNF catalog will begin next week. Included in the mailing are all individuals who have applied for admission, all prospective students on the Student Mailing List, community college counselors, and various members of the public and community college press. Requests for other mailings should be directed to the office of the registrar.

A quantity of catalogs will be distributed among the staff for reference and for handouts to individuals but mailings should be coordinated through the registrar's office in order to avoid duplication.

A NOTE OF CAUTION - We've been waiting a long time for the catalog because, like our building, the catalog is a sign that we've arrived as a university. In our eagerness and pride, however, let us be somewhat restrained in its distribution. The catalog should be given primarily to prospective students or those who interact with students, e.g., counselors, community college instructors. It ought not be given away lightly. We have a sufficient stock of brochures to give to the general public or to the marginally interested prospective student.

THE LAST WORD

To all those employees earning \$7,800.00 or more during the past year: As a result of revising last year's W-2's whereby one bi-weekly pay period was moved from last year to this year, it will become necessary to make a double deduction for FICA taxes for one payroll period. This deduction will be made in the check covering payroll period ending March 23, 1972 which you will receive on March 31, 1972.
