SUBJECT: June 1976 Commencement

The Commencement Exercises will be held Friday, June 18, 1976 at eight o'clock in the evening in the Civic Auditorium. The speaker will be Dr. Solen T. Kimball, Graduate Research Professor of Anthropology, University of Florida, Gainesville, Florida.

Faculty and staff will form their line of march for the processional at 7:25 p.m. in the West end of the South Promenade (Nearest St. Johns River) in columns of two's. There will be a sign designating the assembly point.

For your information, the order of the Processional will be (1) August, December, and March graduates, (2) June degree candidates, (3) faculty and staff, and (4) those who will sit on the platform. The order is reversed for the Recessional.

There will be an Awards Ceremony in the Breezeway in front of Building 001 at 7:30 p.m. on June 17, 1976. Following this ceremony, there will be a reception on the Boathouse Deck and the University's lakefront for the graduates and candidates and their relatives and friends.
