Starring will be some of the top musicians in Latin and jazz. Working in both idioms for over two decades is headline star, Ray Barretto, voted #1 conga player in Latin N.Y. magazine's 1975 music poll. Alan Dawson, who was featured with the Dave Brubeck Quartet from 1968 to 1975, will star on drums. Eddie Martinez, who will be featured on piano, is best known for his work with Gato Barbieri and Ray Barretto. Brilliant alto-saxo-

phone player, Sonny Fortune, and former trumpet player with Blood, Sweat and Tears, Lew Soloff, are both known for their work with jazz and Latin groups. Jack Wilkins will be featured on guitar. He formerly played with Buddy Rich's big band and now plays jazz clubs around New York. Bassist Richard Davis has played with the Thad Jones-Mel Lewis orchestra, and has led his own groups. Also appearing that night will be jazz pianist, Patti Wicks.

As if that wasn't enough, there was the great Sonny Fortune on alto sax—when he teamed up with Eddy Martinez on electric piano, their "Body and Soul" duet really made the joint tingle! As for trumpets, there was Lew Soloff, who played with Blood, Sweat And Tears, and was here joined by surprise guests Waymon reed and Jon Faddis—three

There were memorable quiet moments, too, such as the fine duet featuring Richard Davis on bass and Jack Wilkins on guitar. And further pianistic excitement when Patti Wicks came on for her "Ugetsu" solo, following it up with jazzy vocals like "Have You Met Old Jones?"

Everyone was there for the grand finale (except Sonny Fortune, who had to make it to the Village Vanguard, and Waymon Reed, who's playing at Boomer's). Kleinsinger really goes all out to get the cream of the crop for these concerts, and you can mark April 21st on your calendar for the next one, featuring "Voices of azz."



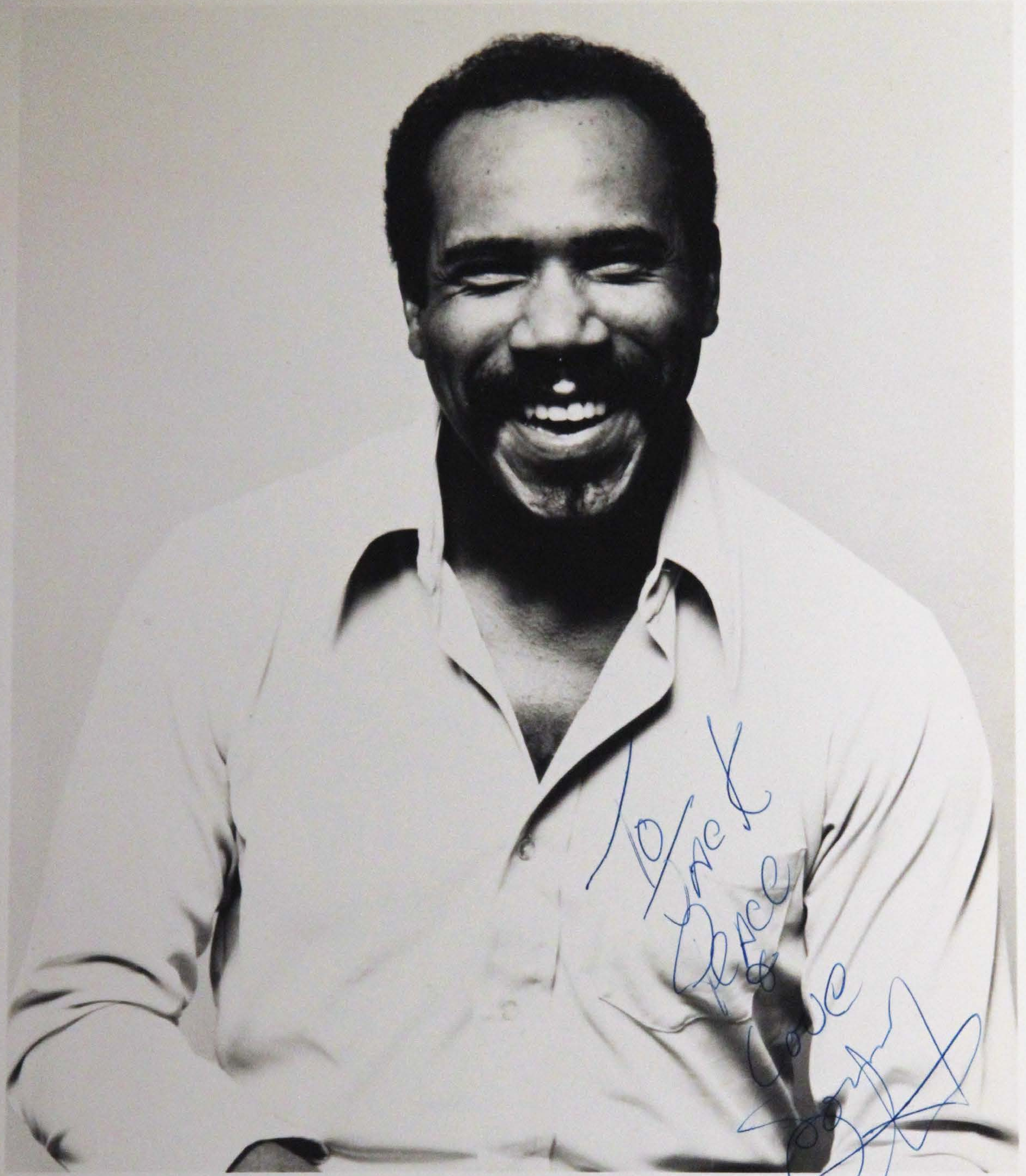

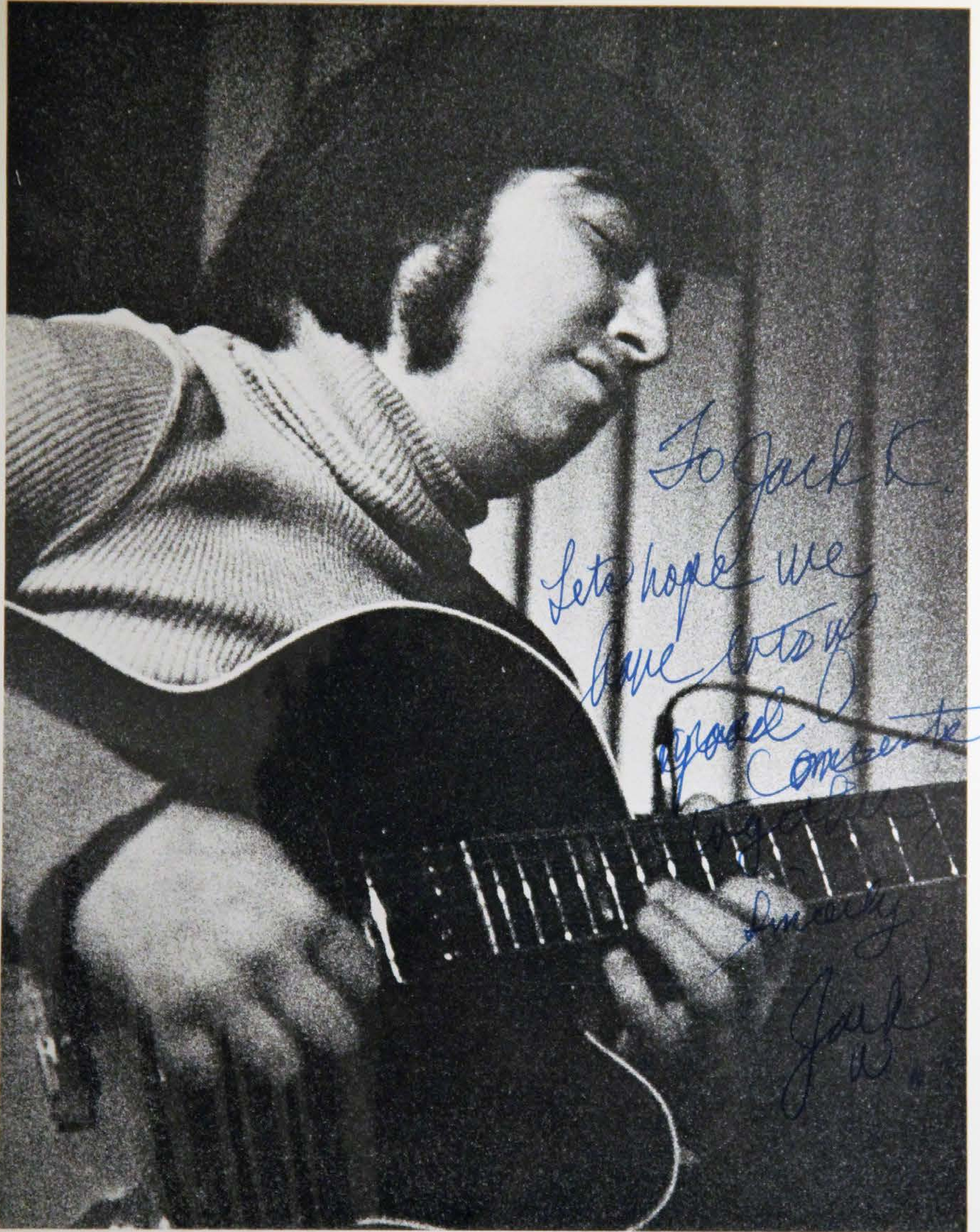
