Born in Joplin, Missouri, February 1, 1902, Mr. Hughes has been described often by literary critics as "a poet of the present generation who interprets first of all life itself". He writes with a depth of understanding and range of knowledge which transcend the barriers of race. His books have been translated into French, Italian, Spanish, Swedish, Chinese, and other languages abroad. He has written for radio, motion pictures, Broadway revues, and for such concert artists as Marion Anderson, Lawrence Tibbett and Muriel Rahn.

A former visiting professor in Creative Writing at Atlanta University, and author of "Simple Takes a Wife" and "Famous American Negroes" published this year, we are happy to welcome Mr. Langston Hughes to our campus at this time.
