deepest, sincerest-sympathy.

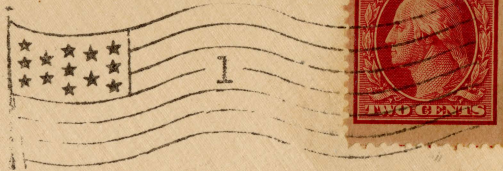
I pray that the One, who
