Jacksonville is a great seaport. One hundred years ago this same water front was thick with the spars of sailing craft. Today it is one of the most active ports on the east coast of the United States.

As a result there is nothing the yachtsman's heart might desire that cannot be found within a few minutes of the St. Johns River Marina — everything from a major overhaul to sail-making to electronic navigation equipment.

Visit Fort Caroline, the site of the **first** European settlement in the United States. See Jacksonville's famed Gator Bowl sports complex, and the Jacksonville Auditorium, directly across the river from the Marina, where plays, concerts, and art exhibits may be seen. Art galleries, libraries, rose gardens, and a special children's museum — your Marina attendant will show you how to get to all of them. And why not travel to the top of one of Jacksonville's new river-front office buildings —

you'll enjoy one of the most spectacular vistas in America — the widening St. Johns River from above the city!

We have accommodations for boats up to 108 feet at the Marina. Attendants are on duty from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. and there is a watchman on guard at all times. Gasoline, marine lubricants and diesel fuel are available. There are water and electricity outlets at each dock.

Slip rental is 5¢ per foot overnight with a minimum of \$1.00 per day, including electricity. There is no charge for short periods of dockage unless electricity plug-in is required.

Jacksonville's St. Johns River Marina is part of a beautiful municipal park with the largest, tallest and most spectacular lighted fountain in the world in the background.

For those who wish to regain their shore legs, there are fine motels, hotels and restaurants within a short distance of your mooring.
