Are they making great preparations for the meeting there?

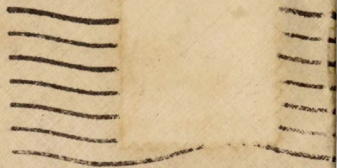
Club work is practically dead here. Very dull indeed.
