vvery pleasant and cool.

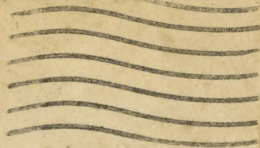
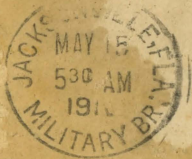
I trust you are O. K.
