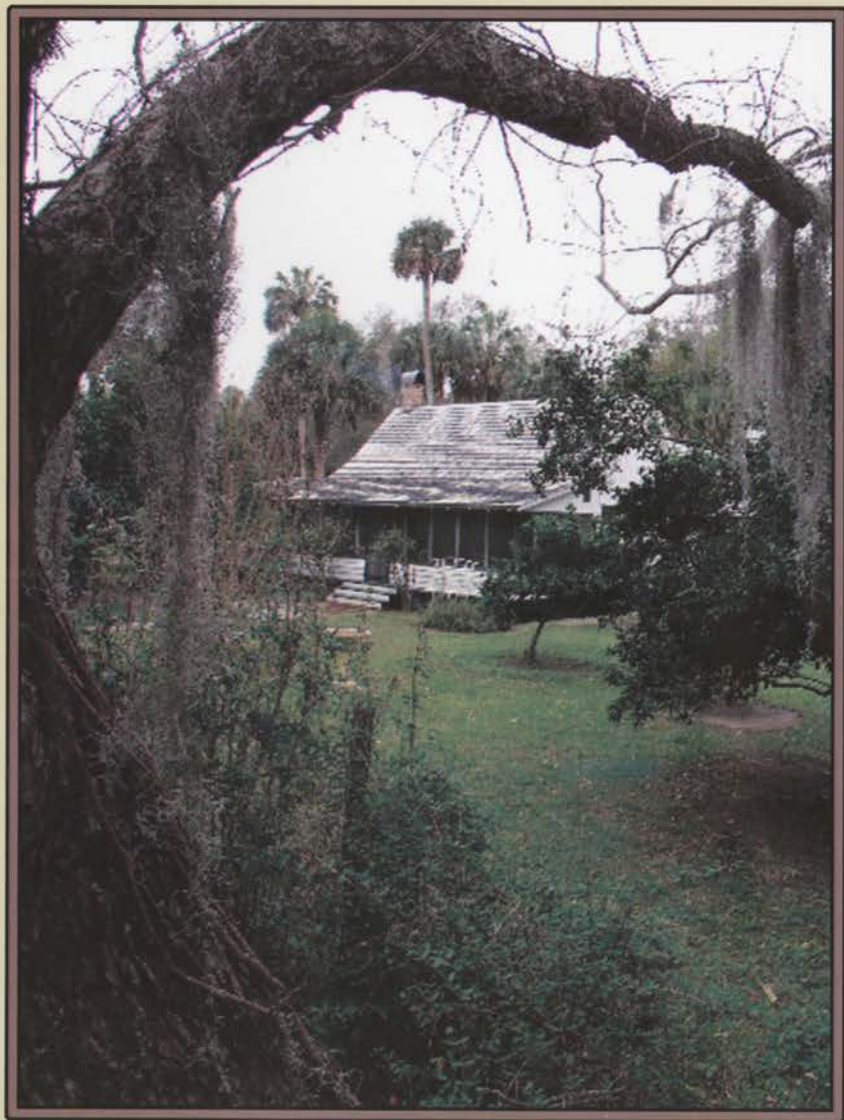


Marjorie Kinnan Rawlings
