

Since becoming the fifth permanent president of UNF in July 2003, **John A. Delaney** has been working with students, faculty, staff, the Board of Trustees and the community on a vision that leads the University on a "journey to greatness." This journey is guided by four principles: a commitment to excellence, focus, relevance and accountability.

The University's definition of excellence begins with a focus on quality instruction and learning opportunities for students. Before being elected mayor, Delaney served as the city's general counsel and chief of staff to former Jacksonville Mayor Ed Austin. Delaney began his career as a prosecutor in the State Attorney's Office.

Delaney received his undergraduate and law degrees from the University of Florida.

## FALL 2008 SENIOR SERVICE AWARD RECIPIENT JESSICA ROCKWOOD

essica Rockwood has been selected by the UNF Alumni Association as the recipient of the Senior Service Award for the Fall 2008 graduating class. The UNF Alumni Association selects a graduating senior each semester for outstanding service to the University and the community through volunteerism.

Jessica is graduating today with a Bachelor of Science degree in Biology and a G.P.A. of 3.82. She has become well known on the UNF campus and in the community. Over the past four years, Jessica has volunteered in several capacities including serving as a medical

volunteer in Haiti with Students Without Borders, a mentor with UNF Community Scholars for an at-risk high school student, a volunteer in the Mayo Clinic's Emergency Department and participating in two Alternative Spring Break service trips to Ecuador. As Vice President of Students Without Borders, Jessica helped transform the UNF campus club into the international organization it is today including planning and participating in a relief trip to Haiti.

Jessica's compassion and drive is focused on serving those in need, and more specifically, those in the most impoverished areas of the globe. She feels strongly about her ability to not just help those in need but to teach them how to help themselves and each other, and thus, change the world. During her time at UNF, Jessica collaborated on



research regarding environmental sustainability and medicinal properties of tropical plants to further her knowledge of how to make these changes. Although Jessica feels that all volunteer experience is important, her most rewarding experience was the trip to Haiti during her Spring Break in 2008. While traveling with the Students Without Borders team, Jessica was not only provided opportunities to interact with, learn from and help people who are culturally different than herself, but the trip also solidified her passion for service and her future in the medical field. "It forced me to dip into the very core of my soul,

whereby I realized that when there is a will and a passion to help people in need, willing and able bodies can make marvelous things happen." For Jessica, volunteering has given her a sense of purpose, accomplishment, social responsibility as well as confidence in her career goals for the future. Following graduation Jessica hopes to continue on to medical school with plans of working with medical mission teams in destitute areas of the world.

In all, Jessica has definitely made an impact not only at UNF and in the Jacksonville community, but internationally. ### TRADITIONS OF THE COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY

Academic regalia date to European universities of the Middle Ages, when gowns and hoods were required for warmth in unheated buildings. Gowns were furlined adaptations of the priestly toga, and hoods were worn to protect the tonsured heads of the priests. The regalia now serve as a visible reminder of the historic antecedents of intellectual pursuits.

In American universities of the late 19th century, these medieval costumes were revived to lend color to academic functions. Efforts were made to establish a code that would set standards for academic dress. Gowns of masters and doctors are generally ankle length and closed in front. The master's gown has pointed sleeves that are slit at the elbows. The doctoral gown has wide lapels of velvet, either black or the color of the scholar's specialization. The sleeves are full and bellshaped, with three velvet chevrons, either black or colored like the lapels. Gowns normally are black, although some universities have designed their own in the colors of the institution.

The hood, which drapes over the back of the gown, carries the greatest symbolism of all components of the academic costume. Its length, width and colors denote the wearer's highest academic achievement and institution. The master's hood is pointed; the doctoral hood is bellshaped. The color of the border of the hood indicates the scholar's major field of study; the lining color or colors identifies the institution that conferred the wearer's degree. Hoods were originally trimmed in fur, but now have satin borders for masters' and velvet for doctors' hoods.

The customary head covering is the mortarboard, or Oxford cap, with a tassel on the left side. Persons who possess the doctorate wear a tassel of gold metallic threads. The soft, large beret, modeled after the cap of Cambridge University, also has been adopted by some institutions.

The medieval university was much concerned with rank and privilege, and academic robes made visible the social and academic distinctions of the wearers. These distinctions have largely disappeared, and robes now indicate specialization. The following colors are associated with the degrees frequently represented in academic processions:

### THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH FLORIDA

The University of North Florida (UNF), one of the 11 public institutions in the State of Florida, is a comprehensive urban university that offers degree programs at the bachelor, masters, and doctorate levels. Established in 1965 as an upper division and professional graduate institution, the University began offering classes in 1972. Freshman and sophomores were added to the student body in 1984. UNF's scenic campus is now nestled among 1300 acres which includes a nature and wildlife area with lakes and nature trails.

The University of North Florida is accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools to award to award baccalaureate, masters, and doctorate degrees. Some professional associations offer further accreditation of specific programs. UNF programs in athletic training, building construction management, business administration, civil engineering, computer science, electrical engineering, health administration, information systems, mechanical engineering, music, nurse anesthesia nursing, nutrition, physical therapy, public administration, rehabilitation counseling, and teacher education have been accorded national accreditation.

As UNF grows, it is proud of maintaining a reputation for excellence which attracts a diverse group of highly qualified students. The Fall 2008 freshman class had a mean SAT score of 1191 and a grade point average of 3.72. The minimum scores typically expected for admission are a sliding scale equivalent of 680 on the SAT (or the ACT equivalent) and a GPA of 2.63. Fourteen percent were in the top 10 percent of their graduating class. Minority students comprise 22.51% of the student body. International students make up 2.03% of the mix: 313 students from 75

countries around the world, 57.60% of UNF students are women; the average student age is 24.46. Academic programs are built on a strong foundation in the traditional arts and sciences. The University now has a student body of over 15,400 students enrolled in 53 undergraduate degree programs with 82 areas of concentration, 27 masters degree programs with 62 areas of concentration, and-three doctoral degrees. It has 558 faculty and more then 1000 full-time and part-time staff. UNF now grants over 3.300 Bachelor, Masters, and Doctoral degrees each year through its College of Arts & Sciences, Coggin College of Business, College of Education and Human Services. Brooks College of Health, and College of Computing, Engineering, and Construction.

UNF is dedicated to excellence in teaching, research, and public service. The University's faculty is committed to providing high-quality instruction, with particular emphasis on undergraduate education. The faculty's publications and other creative activity demonstrate a determination to remain at the cutting edge of intellectual inquiry and practice their respective disciplines. The University – through centers and institutes as well as traditional educational offerings and activities – is a major contributor to the community life of Northeast Florida and, indeed, to the larger community. Four programs have received flagship designation: Transportation & Logistics, International Business, Community Nursing and Coastal Biology.

Through the strong support of the University of North Florida Foundation Inc. and the generosity of both corporate leaders and dedicated citizens of Florida's First Coast region, UNF now has four Eminent Scholar Chairs: the Andrew A. Robinson Chair in Educational Policy and Economic Development, the Ira M. Koger Chair in American Music, the Prime F. Osborn Chair in Transportation, and the Paper Plastics Education Research Foundation Endowed Chair for Supply Chain Management. The UNF Foundation, funded by contributions, supports a wide range of UNF's activities on campus and in the community.
