Constitutional Ratification  
# 83-162

1. Section 4. Student Government Association. The Student Government Association  
2. shall be concerned with the allocation of the Activity and Service fee; the  
3. evaluation and establishment of student programs; student activities, clubs  
4. and organizations, publications and services; student morale, welfare and  
5. conduct; student compensation, fringe benefits, and working conditions; student  
6. financial aid, health, and child care services; student recognition and awards;  
7. athletics; and such other activities as may pertain directly to students.

8. Decisions reached by the Association regarding these matters shall be forwarded  
9. to the Chief Student Affairs Officer, who shall transmit them to the President of  
10. the University with recommendations within 10 working days of receipt. Upon  
11. approval of the President of the University, these decisions shall become the  
12. policies, practices, and regulations of the University.

13. The membership of the student body as represented by the Student Government  
14. Association shall consist of all full and part-time students currently registered  
15. and paying Activity and Service fees to the University.
