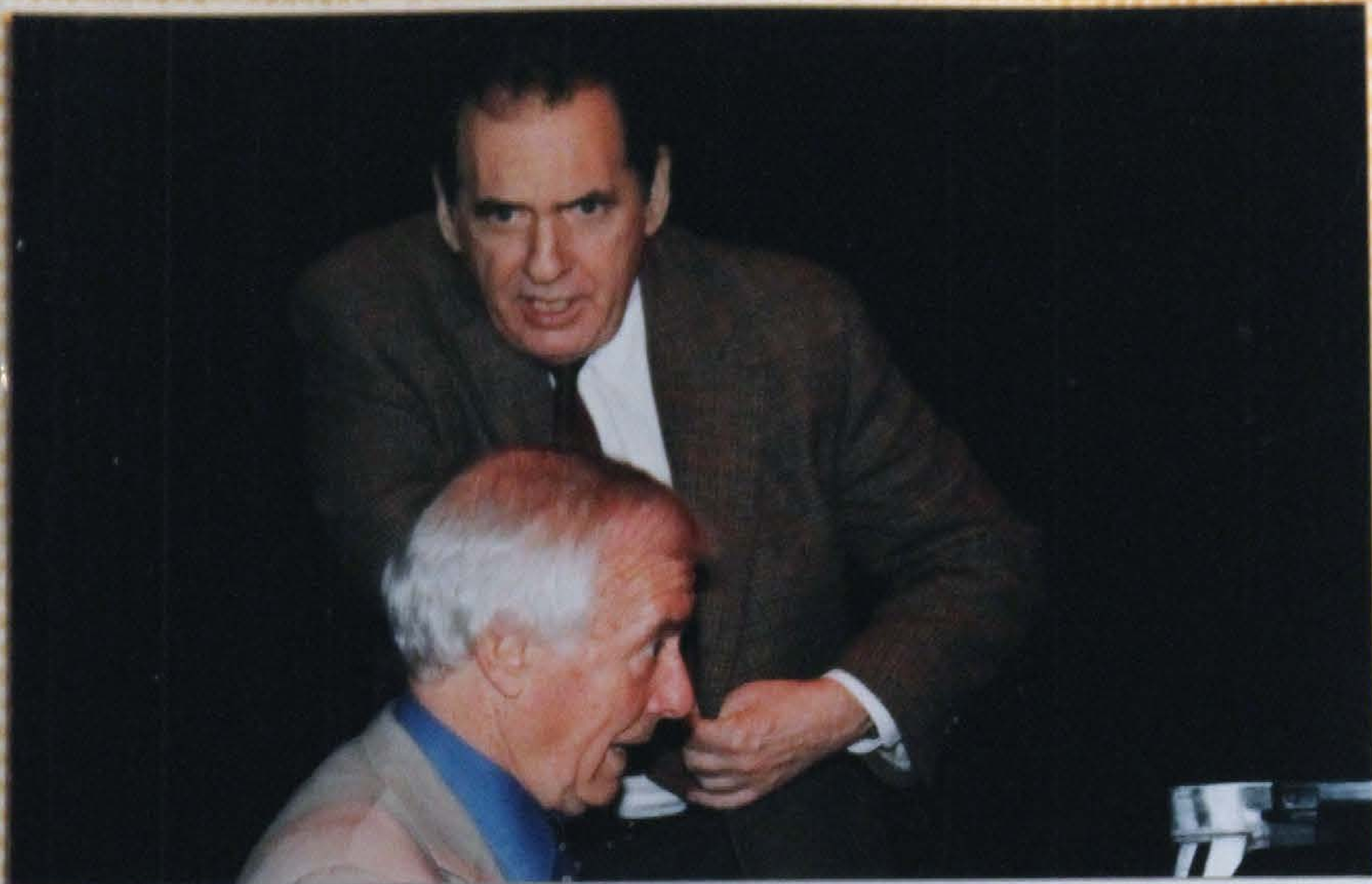
By car take FDR Drive south to end, through underpass onto West Street, north to Chambers.
