SUBJECT: MANAGEMENT APPOINTMENT
Senior Vice President - Private Business Operations

Based on a review of 1983 and long-range plans, we have determined that the extensive amount of program activity in both Private Business and Government Programs warrants the assignment of separate senior management direction to each of those areas. At the same time that we must concentrate on improved customer service and systems development within the private business area, we must also prepare for major changes in the Medicare program administration and competitive procurement practices. This separation of responsibilities will permit senior management to devote more of its time to private business without sacrificing the excellent progress that has been made in government programs administration.

Effective immediately, Mr. George A. Brown will assume the position of Senior Vice President, Private Business Operations. Although he will now report directly to me, his accountabilities will remain the same. Additional announcements will be made over the next several weeks pertaining to private business operations.

Mr. J. Dan Lewis will continue reporting to me in the role of Senior Vice President, Government Program Operations. Reporting to Dan will be Tony Favino, Vice President - Medicare Part A; Nathan Oplinger, Vice President - Medicare Part B; and Bill Dodd, Vice President - Operations Planning.

I know that you will join me in extending your full support and cooperation to both Dan and George in these two critical operational areas.
