# LOGOS (Logic/Order)

Preplanned meetings with other officers

Agendas distributed and followed

Bylaws, Roberts Rules of Order, studied, and accessible

Parliamentarian? Sergeant at Arms?

Arrive early/start on time/end on time

# Finally:

Be sure someone always "has your back."

Decide what your goal(s) are both personal and organizational.

Have your other officers and colleagues help set the organizational goals.

Once you have set these goals, devise the overall strategy for achieving them and the tactics necessary.
