

FINAL EXAMINATION PROCEDURE FOR FALL TERM 2001 SPC 2600

For the larger MWF classes, it is apparent that more time is needed not only for the students' preparation, but for the delivery of the final examination speeches as well. Also, more evaluative information is often provided on these final speeches than on the previous speeches; therefore, more grading time may be required.

Thus, in order to provide the additional time needed for student preparation, the scheduled final examination period of approximately two hours will be utilized for the final speeches that were not completed during the preceding regularly scheduled class time.

In order to provide more comprehensive information and, if necessary, to review the tapes of these final speeches, it will be necessary to retain **ALL** speeches until the end of the final examination period. Retention of these speeches includes **all final speeches—those delivered during regular class time and those delivered during scheduled final examination period.**

All the graded speeches will be available for students outside T-268 on the day that final grades are due at the Registrar's Office (usually the day after final exam period ends) and these finals will remain available outside T-268 until the end of the first week of the next term.
