SKIP BUERGER NAMED NEW PAYROLL MANAGER

The promotion of Skip Buerger to the newly created position of Manager of Payroll has been announced by Jack Brown, Director of Finance, effective June 23. Skip reports directly to Mary Bondurant, Assistant Director of Finance - Accounting.

There are eight employees in Payroll in addition to Skip who are responsible for getting out your payroll check every two weeks. This department also handles all reporting required by state and federal agencies. According to Skip, our payroll for approximately 3,750 employees accounts for 80% of our annual corporate costs.

Skip first came to the Plans in February, 1968 and worked his way up to Lead Programmer in September, 1969. He held this position until June, 1973 when he was promoted to a Systems Analyst. A year and a half later he was promoted to a Finance Control Analyst in Finance Quality Control.

He's a native of Ft. Walton Beach, Florida and received his B.A. degree in Political Science from the University of North Florida this past May. He earned this by attending at night the last three years and took advantage of the company's Tuition Refund Program for financial assistance.
