WHEREAS;	The provisionary language of the 1990-91 Fiscal year's budget states that 100% of the Aquatics center Activity and Service Fee money be transferred to the Aquatics Center Auxiliary Account, and;
WHEREAS;	It is the responsibility of the Budget and Allocations Committee to transfer this money based on the current standing of the Account, and;
WHEREAS;	The Aquatics Center is operating well within the financial boundaries set by the Activity and Service Fee Policies and Procedures, and;
WHEREAS;	The Aquatics Center has no access to the A&S portion of their money until it is placed in their Auxiliary account.
THEREFORE;	Let it be resolved that \$78,948.00 be transferred from the Aquatics Center A&S account(907037000) to the Aquatics Center Auxiliary Account(902501000) to allow for the continued operation of the pool.
