## Number SB 925-681

WHEREAS;

The provisionary language of the 1991-92 Activity and Service Fee Budget states that 100% of the Aqautics Center A&S Fee money be transferred to the Aquatics Center Auxiliary Account, and;

WHEREAS; It is the responsibility of the Budget and Allocations Committee to transfer this money based on the current standing of the Account, and;

WHEREAS; The Aqautices Center is operating well within the financial boundaries set by the Activity and Service Fee Policies and Procedures, and;

WHEREAS;

The Aquatics Center has no access to the A&S portion if their money until it is placed in their Auxiliary Account.

THEREFORE; LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT \$78,808.41 be transferred from the Aqautics Center A&S account (907037000) to the Auquatics Center Auxiliary Account (902501000) to allow for continued operation of the pool.
