NUMBER SB 93F-789

Whereas: At the end of the 92/93 fiscal year, three clubs made purchases utilizing their SGA accounts, and;

Whereas: The three clubs were in good standing with ACSOP and had the funds available in their SGA accounts, and;

Whereas: The accounting system rolled over into fiscal year 93/94 before monies were debited to the accounts, resulting in this year's account being short monies spent last year, and;

Whereas: The monies remaining in the club accounts (equal to the amount they tried to spend) were transferred back into the general operating account,

Therefore: Let it be resolved that \$363.01 be transferred from unallocated account (907098000) into ACSOP operating account (907013000), thereby covering the shortage for the following clubs.
