SENATE LEGISLATION

NUMBER SB 96S-912

WHEREAS: The Student Programming Board is an A & S funded entity, and;

WHEREAS: The board provides various entertainment activities for the students year round, and;

WHEREAS: The board has two full time staff members that help coordinate, advise, keep permanent records, and deal with administration as needed, and;

WHEREAS: The current computer equipment used to aid the staff in their employment is in poor operating condition and no longer adequate to serve the needs of the board and the students.

THEREFORE: Let it be resolved that \$10,914.00 be allocated from the Unallocated Reserve Account (#907098000) to the Student Programming Board for the replacement of the equipment.
