Many of Chicago's labor unions and community organizations are currently fighting for passage of the Chicago Jobs and Living Wage Ordinance. We invite you to join us for a very special "Living Wage Tour of Chicago" so that you may hear from poverty-wage workers and see the devastation that publicly subsidized low-wage work is creating for Chicago's neighborhoods. Currently, the City of Chicago has no living wage policy, and often gives tax breaks, contracts, and other public dollars to companies that hold down the wages of working Chicagoans. The Chicago Jobs and Living Wage Ordinance would change this by promoting a living wage of \$7.60. Despite support from Democrats far and wide, and from more than two-thirds of the City Council, Mayor Richard M. Daley has thus far refused to support the measure. By joining us in solidarity with low-wage working women and men of Chicago, you will help make passage of this important legislation increasingly inevitable!
