## NUMBER SB-97S-987

Whereas: With the Spring Elections begining a number of conflicting situations have been discovered in dealing with Title VI: The Election Statutes of the Constitutional Statutes, and

- Whereas: One of these conflicting situations is the definition of a Ticket, and
- Whereas: It is the duty of the Constitution and Statutes Committee to review problems such as this and formulate an answer, so
- **Therefore:** Let is be resolved that Title VI: The Election Statutes, Chapter 600 Definitions, add a new subsection 600.1 F, that states: Ticket - a list of candidates, totaling no more than two (2), for any given election for the same branch of government. A vote for that ticket will count equally for each candidate on the ticket.
