SENATE LEGISLATION

NUMBER SR-97S-991

Whereas: Maximum attendance by Senators is needed to properly conduct the business of the Student Government Association Senate and its committees, and:

Whereas: More student involvement in the Student Government Association by the general student body could be increased, and:

Whereas: At a minimal cost, (current minimum wage), to SGA this could be accomplished,so:

Therefore: Let it be enacted that members of Senate be monetarily compensated for their time at Senate meetings, committee meetings, weekly office hours, and or official SGA business. The bi-weekly total should not exceed six (6) hours, and Senators may be fined for missed meetings. This fine shall not exceed ten dollars (\$10.00) which will be donated to the Adopt-A-Family holiday fund. Senators will be responsible for accounting for the legitimate usage of their office hours, to include but not limited to, answering phones, errands, and other official duties that may arise. Let it also be enacted that money allocated for wage, that is not used, be returned to unallocated reserve.
