SENATE LEGISLATION

NUMBER Senate Resolution 97S-1003

WHEREAS: The UNF Campus Safety Advisory Council is requesting an official action from the Student Government Association regarding the University Student Directory, and;

WHEREAS: Under current procedures, student data will be included in the Directory *unless* students sign a form requesting exclusion. The required forms are available *only* in Records and Registration and must be turned in there, and;

WHEREAS: The information furnished in the Directory and the need to complete this form to prevent personal information from being published is contained in the University catalogs and course schedules, but is not **highlighted** in any fashion, and;

WHEREAS: The University Council's Personal Safety Subcommittee's concern was that students who may have a valid reason to wish to be excluded from the directory may not be aware of the fact, and;

WHEREAS: Several efforts were made between the Council's Subcommittee and Records & Registration in an attempt to devise a system whereby students could positively affirm their approval of publishing their personal data, and;

WHEREAS: Although the Council is fully aware of the benefits that such a directory may bring to both the University and its students, the members are very concerned about the potential for harm which exists under the current procedures, and;

THEREFORE: Let it be resolved by the Student Government Senate that support of the Student Directory be withdrawn due to the overwhelming dissatisfaction with the current procedures.

Be it further resolved that: A copy of this resolution, including the official Seal of the University be sent to the members of the UNF Campus Safety Advisory Council, the Vice President of Student Affairs, and the University President.
