SENATE LEGISLATION

NUMBER SB-97F-1008

Whereas: It was brought to the attention of the Constitution & Statutes Committee by Senator Janie Clements, Chairperson of the Elections Selections & Appointment Committee, that Title VI: The Election Statutes, Chapter 606.6, section H, only allowed the UNF ID card as a means of voter identification and verification, and

Whereas: To ensure maximum participation in future elections and not to discriminate against students who have not purchased a UNF ID card at the time of said elections then other means of valid identification should be allowed to be used as a means of voter verification, so

Therefore: Let it be enacted by the Student Senate that an amendment be added to Title VI: The Election Statutes, Chapter 606.6, section H, that reads "The University of North Florida student identification card or any other valid picture identification shall serve as a student voter registration card for campus elections.
