SENATE LEGISLATION

NUMBER SB - 98F - 1092

WHEREAS: The Student Government Association of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

WHEREAS: The budget and Allocations Committee is one of four standing committees of the SGA Senate, which is responsible for the management of the A&S Budget, included in this, the Student Conference Travel and Unallocated Reserve Accounts, and;

WHEREAS: Christian Life is a student organization of the University of North Florida, and;

WHEREAS: Christian Life is requesting monies for a women's conference in St. Louis, Missouri, and;

WHEREAS: The breakdown of monies is as follows:

Registration	2 persons	\$118
Accommodations	1 room	\$69
Transportation	Airfare	\$422

Total \$609

THEREFORE: Let it be enacted that \$609 be allocated from the Student Conference Travel and Unallocated Reserve Account to allow Christian Life to attend a conference in St. Louis, Missouri.
