SENATE LEGISLATION

NUMBER SB-99S-1125

Changes the GPA requirements for membership and participation.

- Whereas: The Student Government Association of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
- Whereas: The Constitution and Statutes Committee is standing committee of the Student Government Association Senate, which is responsible for "jurisdiction over all Student Government Association Statutes," and;
- Whereas: The Student Government Association is the forerunner of all student clubs and organizations, and;
- Whereas: The Student Government Association should uphold and stress the importance of high academic standards, and
- Whereas: The new GPA requirement shall commence after the spring of 1999 elections, for those candidates seeking appointment in the summer term; and,
- Therefore: Let it be enacted that Title X, 1001.1 B state "All Student Government Association officials shall maintain a cumulative University of North Florida grade point average of at least 2.25 on a 4.0 scale." Likewise, Title X, 1004.1 A states "Student Government Association members who do not maintain a cumulative University of North Florida grade point average of 2.25/ 4.0 scale are entitled to a Probationary Period of one semester, in order to raise his/her grade point average to a 2.25/4.0 scale."
