SENATE LEGISLATION

NUMBER SB-99S-1139

Clarifies the appointment process of the Judicial Council

Whereas: The Student Government Association of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

Whereas: The Constitution and Statues Committee is standing committee of the Student Government Association Senate, which is responsible for "jurisdiction over Student Government Association Statutes," and;

Whereas: Section 505.3, of Title V states: "If a vacancy [on the Judiciary Council] occurs, the Student Government Association President may appoint, subject to confirmation by the Student Senate, a replacement for the remainder of their concurrent term," and to provide for more consistency throughout the Statutes of the Student Government Association;

Therefore: Let it be enacted that 505.3 of Title V be have additions that read:

- A. Recruitment shall be conducted by the Student Government Association membership at large, and more specifically by the Judicial Council.
- B. This pattern shall continue perpetually.
