# SENATE RESOLUTION

NUMBER SR-99S-1148

*Referendum for the 1999 Spring Elections concerning a Constitutional Change concerning terminology.*

- Whereas: The Student Government Association of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
- Whereas: The Constitution and Statutes Committee is standing committee of the Student Government Association Senate, which is responsible for "jurisdiction over Student Government Association Statutes," and;
- Whereas: A Constitutional change requires a majority vote by the student body, and;
- Whereas: The Constitution and Statutes Committee recommends that a Referendum should be placed on the 1999 Spring Elections' Ballot, and;
- Therefore: Let it be resolved that a Referendum will be placed on the 1999 Spring Elections' ballot that states: "Should the term *Judicial Council* be changed to read the *Office of the Judiciary* in the Student Government Constitution and all of the Statutes?"
