SENATE LEGISLATION

NUMBER SB-99S-1169

Clarifies who will break a tie in Impeachment hearings

- Whereas: The Constitution and Statutes Committee is standing committee of the Student Government Association Senate, which is responsible for "jurisdiction over all Student Government Association Statutes, except for Title VI and VIII..." as stated in Title IX, subsection 901.1.C.1.a., and;
- Whereas: The Impeachment Statutes are to be reviewed and changed as the Constitution and Statutes Committee sees fit, and;
- Whereas: 701.2 Pertains to the procedures of the Impeachment hearings, and;
- Whereas: The Constitution and Statutes Committee recommends that the Chief Justice should be break a tie, unless the hearing involves a justice being impeached, and;
- Therefore: **LET IT BE ENACTED THAT "SECTION 701.2G BE ADDED TO READ "THE CHIEF JUSTICE SHALL BREAK A TIE IN IMPEACHMENT HEARINGS, ONLY IF IT IS NOT A JUSTICE THAT IS BEING TRIED. IN THE CASE THAT A JUSTICE IS BEING TRIED, THE VICE PRESIDENT OF THE STUDENT BODY SHALL BE THE TIE BREAKER."**
