SENATE RESOLUTION

Number SR-99S-1171

SB-99S-1171 addresses concerns over Green infringement

Whereas:

The Student Government Association of the University of North Florida's purpose is to "represent students in all University-wide matters," as stated in chapter 400.1B in the University of North Florida's Student Government Association Constitutions and Statutes, and;

Whereas:

It has come to the attention of the Student Government Association that the Green in front of Building 14, the Student Life Center, is threatened of encroachment by the landscaping of the proposed Fine Arts Building, and;

Whereas:

The Green is an important programming venue for student, as well as the community, for events such as Earth Music Fest, Homecoming Activities, Club Fest, Health Fairs and Rush activities, and;

Whereas:

The Student Government Association has contributed substantial sums of money for the placement of two power boxes on the Green for outdoor social & educational activities which currently the Quad Area, the only other area which allows for outdoor programming, does not possess, and;

Whereas:

It is imperative that all of the campus constituents be made aware and partake in the decision making processes which will ultimately impact campus life, and;

Therefore:

LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT ANY PROPOSAL WHICH WOULD ENCROACH UPON THE GREEN'S CAPACITY IN ANY MANNER, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO LANDSCAPING AND INFRASTRUCTURE ERECTION, SHOULD REQUIRE THE SOLICITATION AND APPROVAL OF FACULTY, STAFF, AND STUDENTS.
