NUMBER SB-99SA-1191A

---

*Clarifies the eligibility for appointment*

- Whereas: The Student Government Association of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
- Whereas: The Constitution and Statutes Committee is standing committee of the Student Government Association Senate, which is responsible for "jurisdiction over Senate Policies and Procedures"
- Whereas: In sec B under "Membership of the Senate" of the Senate Policies and Procedures
- Therefore: Let it be enacted that this text read:
- "5. To be eligible for appointment to the senate, a student must attend one senate meeting prior to the meeting he/she is seeking appointment. Once sworn in to the position of senator, he/she will immediately possess all senatorial privileges."
