# SENATE LEGISLATION

## NUMBER SB-99SB-1229

*SB-99SB-1129 addresses the revised \$200 scholarship program for members of the Senate and Judiciary.*

- Whereas:** The Student Government Association of the University of North Florida's purpose is to "represent students in all University-wide matters," as stated in chapter 400.1B in the University of North Florida's Student Government Association Constitution and Statutes, and;
- Whereas:** The non-paid student senators and the paid leadership currently do not receive any compensation for the duties enunciated in Chapter 400.1 of Title IV: The Legislative Branch; likewise, the judiciary does not receive compensation for their involvement, and;
- Whereas:** A scholarship created to help accommodate these Senators and Judiciaries for their time and effort would serve as a source of compensation for up to forty members of the Student Senate and up to nine members of the Judiciary, and;
- Whereas:** A \$200 scholarship should be made available each year to all senators who have been elected by the student body in a regularly scheduled Student Government Election and have served their full term of office without violating Chapter 401.1: Senate Absences and the Senate Policies and Procedures, and;
- Whereas:** Members of the Office of the Judiciary must also be active & participatory members of the Student Government Association for a minimum of one full year, while also following the guidelines set forth in the Office of the Judiciary Rules & Procedures, and;
- Whereas:** This practice shall be enacted forthright in the Fall election of 1999, which in effect would have the first scholarship disbursement in the Fall semester of 2000, and;
- Whereas:** The Student Government currently has a reserve account, which generates interest that can be used to fund the Student Senate and Judiciary scholarships, and;
- Therefore:** *Let it be enacted that the interest generated on the Student Government Reserve Account be used to fund the Senate & Judiciary \$200 scholarship as an endeavor to compensate the Student Senate and the Office of the Judiciary for their time, effort, and dedication to the students of University of North Florida and the State University System.*
