SENATE RESOLUTION

NUMBER SR-99FA-1259

SR-99F-1259 Urges the Student Senate to create an AdHoc Committee to explore the feasibilities of a new yearbook program at UNF.

- WHEREAS: The Student Government Association of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
- WHEREAS: The University of North Florida had a yearbook program that produced one book a year for student distribution up until 1978, and;
- WHEREAS: The feasibility of creating a new yearbook program at the University of North Florida is a distinct possibility with the current circumstances, and;
- WHEREAS: Creation of a student-run yearbook would grant new opportunities in the journalistic realm for students, and;
- WHEREAS: This yearbook and its recurring offices would be if approved, under consideration as an agency of the Student Government Association, and;
- THEREFORE: Let it be resolved that the Executive Branch on this day, October 8, 1999, investigate the feasibility of the creation of a yearbook program at the University of North Florida. The Executive Branch should report its findings to the Student Senate by the next two Senate meetings.
