*SENATE LEGISLATION*

NUMBER SB-00S-1291

*SB-00S-1291 allocates travel funds for the American Medical Student Association*

WHEREAS: The Student Government Association of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

WHEREAS: The Budget and Allocations Committee is standing committee of the Student Government Association Senate, which is responsible for "allocation of the Activity and Service Fees," and;

WHEREAS: The Budget and Allocations Committee unanimously agreed upon the following request, and;

WHEREAS: The American Medical Student Association, a University Recognized Organization, requests funds from the Student Conference Travel Account 907027000 for travel to Washington, D.C. to attend the AMSA's 50<sup>th</sup> Annual Convention, and;

WHEREAS: The breakdown of monies is as follows:

Registration Fees: \$99 x 4 persons	=	\$396
Accommodations: \$150 x 4 nights	=	\$600
<u>Transportation: Airline-\$275 x 4</u>	=	<u>\$1100</u>
Total:	=	\$2096

THEREFORE: Let it be enacted that \$2096 be allocated from the Student Government Association's Student Conference and Travel Account for the American Medical Student Association to travel to Washington, D.C. on March 15<sup>th</sup> to the 19<sup>th</sup> for the AMSA's 50<sup>th</sup> Annual Convention.
