### SENATE LEGISLATION

#### NUMBER SB-2000S-1295

SB-2000S-1295 allocates travel funds for the Financial Investment Society

WHEREAS: The Student Government Association of the University of North Florida was established

to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

WHEREAS: The Budget and Allocations Committee is standing committee of the Student

Government Association Senate, which is responsible for "allocation of the Activity and

Service Fees," and;

WHEREAS: The Budget and Allocations Committee unanimously agreed upon the following request,

and;

WHEREAS: The Financial Investment Society, a University Recognized Organization, requests funds

from the Student Conference Travel Account 907027000 for travel to New York to visit

Wall Street, and;

WHEREAS: The breakdown of monies is as follows:

Partial Hotel Accommodations = \$1,500.00 TOTAL = \$1,500.00

THEREFORE: Let it be enacted that \$1,500.00 be allocated from the Student Government Association's Student Conference and Travel Account for the Financial Investment Society to travel to New York City on March 9<sup>th</sup> to the 12<sup>th</sup> to visit Wall Street.
