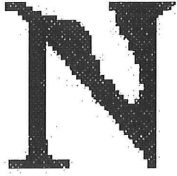

NUMBER SB-2000S-1295

SB-2000S-1295 allocates travel funds for the Financial Investment Society

- WHEREAS: The Student Government Association of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
- WHEREAS: The Budget and Allocations Committee is standing committee of the Student Government Association Senate, which is responsible for "allocation of the Activity and Service Fees," and;
- WHEREAS: The Budget and Allocations Committee unanimously agreed upon the following request, and;
- WHEREAS: The Financial Investment Society, a University Recognized Organization, requests funds from the Student Conference Travel Account 907027000 for travel to New York to visit Wall Street, and;
- WHEREAS: The breakdown of monies is as follows:
