**SENATE LEGISLATION**

NUMBER SB-2000S-1308

*SB-2000S-1308 allocates travel funds for AMA to attend a conference*

WHEREAS: The Student Government Association of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

WHEREAS: The Budget and Allocations Committee is standing committee of the Student Government Association Senate, which is responsible for "allocation of the Activity and Service Fees," and;

WHEREAS: The American Marketing Association requests funds from the Student Conference Travel Account 907027000 for travel to New Orleans to attend the AMA International Collegiate Conference, and;

WHEREAS: The breakdown of monies is as follows:

Transportation :	1 Airline ticket	=	\$ 220.00
Registration Fee:		=	\$154.00
Accommodations:	1 Hotel room x 2 nights	=	\$ 306.00
<b>Total:</b>		=	<b>\$680.00</b>

THEREFORE: Let it be enacted that \$680.00 be allocated from the Student Government Association's Student Conference and Travel Account for the American Marketing Association to travel to New Orleans to attend the AMA International Collegiate on April 13<sup>th</sup> through April 15<sup>th</sup>.
