NUMBER SB-2000S-1308

The Budget and Allocations Committee is standing committee of the Student

Government Association Senate, which is responsible for "allocation of the Activity and

Service Fees," and;

WHEREAS:

The American Marketing Association requests funds from the Student Conference Travel

Account 907027000 for travel to New Orleans to attend the AMA International

Collegiate Conference, and;

WHEREAS:

The breakdown of monies is as follows:

Transportation:

1 Airline ticket

\$ 220.00

Registration Fee:

= \$154.00

Accommodations:

1 Hotel room x 2 nights

\$ 306.00

Total:

= \$680.00

Let it be enacted that \$680.00 be allocated from the Student Government Association's Student Conference and Travel Account for the American Marketing Association to travel to New Orleans to attend the AMA International Collegiate on April 13th through April 15th.
