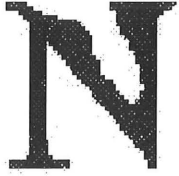

SENATE LEGISLATION

NUMBER SB-2000S-1309

SB-2000S-1309 allocates travel funds for a student to attend a conference

WHEREAS: The Student Government Association of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

WHEREAS: The Budget and Allocations Committee is standing committee of the Student Government Association Senate, which is responsible for "allocation of the Activity and Service Fees," and;

WHEREAS: Christin Coleman requests funds from the Student Conference Travel Account 907027000 for travel to Atlanta to attend the Sixth Southeastern Regional Virology Conference, and;

WHEREAS: The breakdown of monies is as follows:

Registration Fee:	=	\$ 90.00
Accommodations: 1 Hotel room x 2 nights	=	\$ 100.00
Total:	=	\$190.00

THEREFORE: Let it be enacted that \$190.00 be allocated from the Student Government Association's Student Conference and Travel Account for Christin Coleman to attend the Sixth Southeastern Regional Virology Conference in Atlanta on March 24th through March 26th.
