SENATE LEGISLATION

NUMBER SB-2000S-1310

SB-2000S-1310 changes Title VIII, section 803.7

WHEREAS: The Student Government Association of the University of North Florida was established to

represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

WHEREAS: The Budget and Allocations Committee is standing committee of the Student Government

Association Senate, which is responsible for "allocation of the Activity and Service Fees," and;

WHEREAS: The Budget and Allocations Committee oversees the Budget process as defined in Title VIII,

section 803, and;

WHEREAS: In the past, the outgoing student body president has signed the Activity and Service Fees budget

for the future fiscal year, and;

WHEREAS: The Budget and Allocations Committee considers the aforementioned process to be fiscally

irresponsible, since it is the duty of the incoming student body president to follow their respective

budgets, and;

WHEREAS: The Budget and Allocations Committee unanimously voted to amend 803.7, which states:

"Once approved by the SGA Senate, the SGA President, the SGA Executive officers sign the final budget. It is then submitted to the Vice President for Student Affairs, who forwards it to the University President with recommendation. The University President shall have 15 school days from the date of presentation of the budget to act on the allocation and expenditure recommendations. These recommendations shall be deemed approved if no action is taken within 15 school days. If any line item, or portion thereof, within the budget is vetoed by the University President, the SGA Senate, within 15 school days, will make new budget

recommendations for expenditures of the vetoed portion of the budget. If the University President vetoes any line item, or portion thereof, within the new budget revisions, the University President may reallocate by line item that vetoed portion to bond obligations guaranteed by Activity and Service Fees," to make the budget

process fiscally accountable, and;

THEREFORE: Let it be enacted that the following changes be made to 803.7 "Once approved by the SGA

Senate, the SGA President, the SGA Executive officers sign the final budget. the Student Body

President Elect, who will serve under the aforementioned budget, may sign or veto the final

budget. If vetoed, the budget will go back to the Senate, subject to a 2/3rds override. If the

president signs or if it is overridden by the Senate, it is then submitted to the Vice President for

Student Affairs, who forwards it to the University President with recommendation..."

WHEREAS: In the past, the outgoing student body president has signed the Activity and Service Fees budget

for the future fiscal year, and;

WHEREAS: The Budget and Allocations Committee considers the aforementioned process to be fiscally

irresponsible, since it is the duty of the incoming student body president to follow their respective

budgets, and;

WHEREAS: The Budget and Allocations Committee unanimously voted to amend 803.7, which states:

"Once approved by the SGA Senate, the SGA President, the SGA Executive officers sign the final budget. It is then submitted to the Vice President for Student Affairs, who forwards it to the University President with recommendation. The University President shall have 15 school days from the date of presentation of the budget to act on the allocation and expenditure recommendations. These recommendations shall be deemed approved if no action is taken within 15 school days. If any line item, or portion thereof, within the budget is

vetoed by the University President, the SGA Senate, within 15 school days, will make new budget

recommendations for expenditures of the vetoed portion of the budget. If the University President vetoes any line item, or portion thereof, within the new budget revisions, the University President may reallocate by line item that vetoed portion to bond obligations guaranteed by Activity and Service Fees," to make the budget

process fiscally accountable, and;

THEREFORE: Let it be enacted that the following changes be made to 803.7 "Once approved by the SGA

Senate, the SGA President, the SGA Executive officers sign the final budget. the Student Body

President Elect, who will serve under the aforementioned budget, may sign or veto the final

budget. If vetoed, the budget will go back to the Senate, subject to a 2/3rds override. If the president signs or if it is overridden by the Senate, it is then submitted to the Vice President for

Student Affairs, who forwards it to the University President with recommendation...."
