**SENATE LEGISLATION**

NUMBER SB-00S-1320

*SB-00S-1320 allocates travel funds for IEEE to attend and present at a conference*

WHEREAS: The Student Government Association of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

WHEREAS: The Budget and Allocations Committee is standing committee of the Student Government Association Senate, which is responsible for "allocation of the Activity and Service Fees ," and;

WHEREAS: The Institute of Electronics Engineers, a university recognized organization, requests funds from the Student Conference Travel Account 907027000 for travel to Nashville to attend the Southeast Con2000 where they will present their robots in a competition, along with attending meetings and competing for best student webpage, and;

WHEREAS: The breakdown of monies is as follows:

Transportation :	Van-\$34x3 days x 2 vans	=	\$ 204.00
Registration Fee:	\$25 x 9 people	=	\$ 225.00
Accommodations:	2 Hotel rooms \$198 x 2	=	\$ 396.00
<b>Total:</b>		=	<b>\$825.00</b>

THEREFORE: Let it be enacted that \$825.00 be allocated from the Student Government Association's Student Conference and Travel Account for the IEEE to travel to Nashville to attend the SouthEastCon2000 from April 7<sup>th</sup> to the 9<sup>th</sup> .
