SB-00S-1313 Validation of Spring 2000 SGA Election

WHEREAS: The Student Government Association of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

WHEREAS: The Student Government Association holds biannual elections for the purpose of electing new senatorial and executive representatives and in order to poll students on specific referenda;

WHEREAS: The Spring 2000 Election took place April 4 & 5, 2000 and 1,138 students participated;

THEREFORE: Let it be enacted that this election be validated and the following elected representatives take the office to which they were duly and fairly elected:
