thirteen (13) statutes, and;

The Constitution and Statutes Committee determined during its review of Title V that the

following changes are necessary, and;

Therefore:

Let it be enacted that the following changes be made to Title V: The Judicial Branch:

500.2

Any official(s) appearing before any student judiciary the Office of the

Judiciary shall have the following rights:

501.2

Failure by a student party to comply with the directive to appear

before the council, without reasonable cause, may result in the

initiation of punitive action non-compliance.

504.2

If the Chief Justice is unavailable to fulfill his/her duty of

administering the "Oath of Office," it may be administered by another

Justice of the Office of the Judiciary or the Senate President.
