SB-00F-1379 makes general changes to Title XII (Club Alliance Funding Board).

Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

Whereas: The Constitution and Statutes Committee is responsible for "reviewing the SG Constitution and Statutes and recommend any change to the SG Senate when necessary," and;

Whereas: During distribution of copies of Title XII for the Fall semester, several agencies reported differences from the way things are currently run, and;

Whereas: Club Alliance, an agency of Student Government, proposed the following changes, and;

Therefore: Let it be enacted that the following changes be made to Title XII: The Executive Agency Statute.

1205.10.E Each club will be afforded the opportunity to request up to an additional \$200 per fall and spring semester respectively fiscal year. This request will exclude the original club funding.
